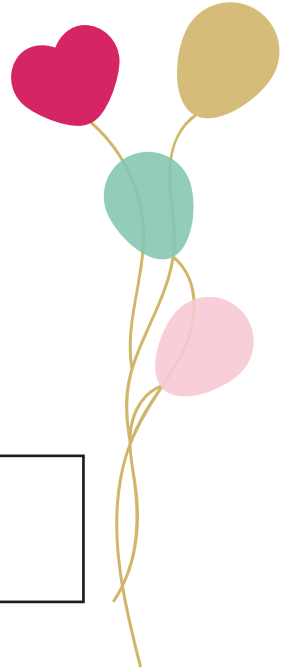


THANKING EVERYONE

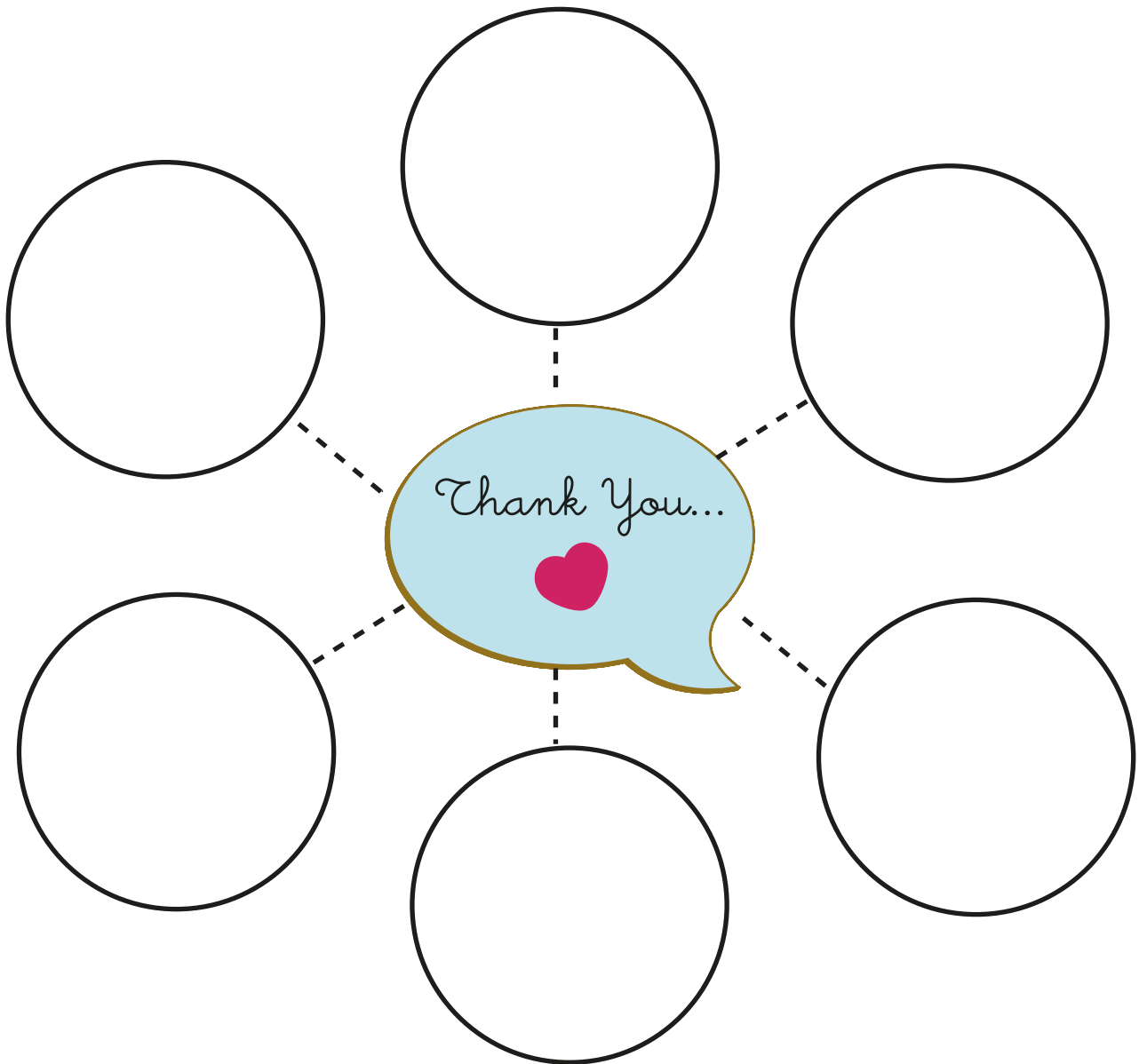
